Traveling by car: Amana is off Interstate 80, via U.S. Route 151 in eastern Iowa.

By air: The closest airport to Amana is Eastern Iowa Airport (CID) in Cedar Rapids, just 15 miles north. Ride share or taxi transportation from the airport to Amana may be available. We will offer **free shuttle service** to and from Eastern Iowa Airport, Cedar Rapids. Anyone needing a ride please contact (**in advance, if possible**) the Amana Heritage Museum at 319-622-3567 or via email amanaheritage@southslope.net Or you may wish to rent a car. Access to conference venues in Main Amana are within walking distance.

Lodging: A small number of rooms have been reserved at the Hotel Millwright (the former Amana Woolen Mill) for \$124 (Tues.-Thurs.)/\$189 (Fri.-Sat.) Call 319-838-5015 and tell them you are with the CSA. Other accommodations include Die Heimat, 319-622-3937 and Zuber's Homestead Hotel 319-622-3911; both in are Homestead about 4 miles south of Main Amana. Other places, either in Main Amana or in the nearby sister villages, include Bed & Breakfast Inns and camping and can be found on the Amana Convention and Visitors Bureau's website www.amanacolonies.com/places-to-stay/
